## **Special Member Meeting - Results of the Bylaw Vote**

NACRO Co-Presidents, Dana Ulrich and Jill Abele, are pleased to announce the revised Bylaws were approved at the Special Member Meeting yesterday. The Strategic Implementation Committee, chaired by Member-at-Large Joseph Huang, brought considerable revisions to the current NACRO Bylaws, which were adopted by membership in July 2017. The voting Members also approved an effective date of July 13, 2023 for the newly revised Bylaws.

A few highlights of the revised Bylaws include:

- Restructuring NACRO volunteer committees
- Clarifying NACRO procedures in Board of Directors nominations, elections and appointments
- Increased access for non-R1 institutions to seek Board of Directors leadership positions

Next, Joseph and volunteers from the current Professional Development and Conference Programming committees will meet regularly to build the new structure of the Professional Education Committee to increase offerings through both virtual and inperson events. The Executive Committee and co-chairs of the Marketing & Communications Committee are soliciting RFPs for a marketing consultant that will allow for a seamless transition into the new Communications Committee.
