

Genome editing with CRISPR in vegetable crops

This global private company is looking for a single base genome editing with CRISPR in vegetable crops for known candidate genes. They are also looking for genome editing leading to chromosome inversion of 2 Mbp to link two beneficial genes. <u>https://hubs.la/Q02422Vj0</u>

"Point-of-Care" tool for DNA/RNA detection

BASF is looking for new point-of-care tools for detection of DNA and/or RNA features in plant material for routine use in non-lab settings. These tools would be used for genetic quality assessment of leaf and seed material. <u>https://hubs.la/Q02421bM0</u>

Modeling plants to create a "digital twin"

This global private company is seeking any therapeutic approach which can achieve long duration of modulated disease progression or severity.
