Co-Presidents' Message



Spring is here! Hopefully you are seeing grass, leaves, and flowers starting to sprout in your area. Here at NACRO, we are happy to announce more growth in member benefits!

Joseph Huang (Stanford University) has served as Member-at-Large on the NACRO board this year. The Member-at-Large position is a voting board member who works on a special project as requested by the co-presidents, rather than lead a committee. We asked Joseph to work on NACRO's alliances with peer associations this year. Over the course of the last six months, Joseph researched eleven different professional associations that support professionals in academia. He evaluated how closely each association aligns with NACRO's mission and values and wrote a quick poll to determine which specific associations were of interest to NACRO members. Joseph prioritized the list and began reaching out to associations, asking whether they'd be interested in developing a formal partnership with NACRO.

Joseph presented his findings to the NACRO board and last month, the board voted

unanimously to approve partnerships with <u>AURP</u> (Association of University Research Parks), <u>CASE</u> (Council for Advancement and Support of Education), <u>NACE</u> (National Association of Colleges and Employers), and <u>NORDP</u> (National Organization of Research Development Professionals). These associations have agreed to support NACRO by providing educational content for our members, whether presenting at the NACRO Conference or in a NACRO webinar. In return, NACRO will provide educational content for the partner associations' conferences. These partnerships will complement the great programs created by our Professional Education Committee, by providing new content for NACRO members at no additional charge. In turn, members of the partner associations will learn about NACRO and be encouraged to join. Diversifying our educational programs and membership will benefit all NACRO members.

Many thanks to board members Jill Abele (lowa State University Foundation), Tracy Curtis (University of Oklahoma), Angela Dudley (Wichita State University), and Joseph Huang for serving as liaisons to our new partners in the first year. Your willingness to serve as NACRO ambassadors in addition to your other leadership duties is much appreciated!

The Financial Metrics Survey is designed to capture the numerous ways in which industry supports higher education – research, philanthropy, executive education, etc. Unlike other tools that record exclusively for research or institutional advancement, this instrument captures all areas that receive funding from industry so that a comprehensive "all-in" understanding of industry impact can be reported. As the survey grows in broad institutional participation and longevity, this data will be an invaluable tool for peer comparisons and detection of best practices in the university-industry interface.
