

### **NACRO Membership Surging**

Our network of academic corporate relations officers continues to see strong membership growth and engagement.

Regional meetings on recent corporate giving trends have drawn an average of 25–30 members, with 10% being new participants. Since March 2024, we have welcomed 139 new members, including 54 who joined after our July 2024 national meeting, contributing to a net membership gain of 8.5% toward our ambitious two-year 20% membership growth target announced our annual conference last year in Raleigh.

With nearly 50% of our 2026 goal already achieved in just seven months, the Membership Committee is actively working to further refine benefits and deepen member value to strengthen our retention. One key example is last month's NACRO Corporate Engagement Bootcamp, which offered valuable training and networking opportunities. We look forward to April's Regional Meetups to generate significant additional value.

In addition, our NACRO Excellence in Equity (EIE) initiative continues to foster deeper, meaningful involvement within our network and beyond. The EIE initiative aims to promote equitable practices and support all members in their professional growth. As of now, 15 organizations have expressed an interest in engaging with our EIE initiative, demonstrating our bedrock commitment to inclusivity and excellence.
